Swanson, born in 1938 in Los Angeles, California, paints in oil, watercolor, acrylic, and mixed media, and is an independent printmaker of limited edition serigraphs, lithographs, etchings, and other prints. In January, 2001, a mosaic reproducing John Swanson's serigraph, GREAT CATCH, was dedicated at Concordia University in Irvine, California. Made by craftsmen in Italy from Byzantine glass, the 6' by 8' mosaic is installed in the foyer of the Grimm Student Union.


